POOL PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES

WARNING: Recreation areas are at all times unsupervised and residents and their guests use them at their own risk.

Any person who is deemed by the Building Manager or Security, at their sole discretion, to break any of the pool protocols and procedures or general spirit of the pool protocols and procedures may be ejected from the Facilities. A subsequent violation could result in a total ban of that person's amenity privileges.

Pool Hours

Sunday to Thursday 8:00 am to 10:00 pm Friday and Saturday 8:00 am to 10:30 pm Statutory Holidays 8:00 am to 10:30 pm

Resident & Guest Policy

- The use of the swimming pool is restricted to residents of Fashion House and their guests. There is a maximum number of two (2) guests per suite. If the number of persons in the pool area exceeds the maximum allowed in accordance with local fire authority's regulations or by-laws, then the rights of other residents will prevail and guests will be asked to leave.
- Residents must accompany their Guests at all times when using the pool.
- Residents are responsible to ensure that both they and their guests are fully aware of all pool rules and regulations.
- The full cost of any damage to the Facilities by a Resident and/or Guest will be the responsibility of the Resident.

Food & Drink Policy

- Non-alcoholic drinks are permitted on the pool deck but at no time in the pool
- Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited
- No food is allowed in pool area at any time

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY:

- No glass or breakable objects in the pool area
- No drinks or food of any kind in the pool
- No smoking
- No illegal drugs
- No throwing, dropping, or reaching over the exterior glass railing or accessing the exterior garden area at any time.
- Boisterous behaviour of any sort including but not limited to: running, jumping, using profane language or other forms of disruptive or disorderly behavior are prohibited within the Facilities at any time.

Safety & Sanitation Policy

- No Resident or Guest shall wear any wet or muddy footwear in and around the pool area.
- Residents and Guests are required to wear bathing attire in and around the pool. Any form of clothing that is
 considered street clothing is not considered proper attire. Residents and Guests must change out of wet
 bathing attire before leaving the change rooms.
- Each bather shall take a shower using warm water and soap and thoroughly rinsed off prior to entering the pool. Suntan oil, cream or any other sun block is not permitted in the pool.
- The pool area is an unsupervised premise; an adult must accompany bathers under the age of 12; an adult is considered an individual that is 18 years of age and older.
- Pregnant women, young children, elderly persons or persons suffering from heart disease, diabetes or high blood pressure should not enter the pool without prior medical consultation with their physician.
- No Resident shall permit any child under the apparent age of 4 and lacking toilet training to use the pool. In addition, rubber pants over diapers and/or use of changing of any diapers is not permitted within the pool area.
- No person infected with a communicable disease or having open sores on his or her body shall be allowed to enter the pool.
- No person shall pollute the water in the pool in any manner including: urinating or defecating in the pool, spitting, spouting of water and blowing of noses in the pool.
- All persons with hair longer than collar length must wear bathing caps.
- Diving or jumping in the pool is prohibited.
- Inflatable children's toys or floats are not permitted in the pool. However, CSA approved life jackets are permitted.
- In the event of an emergency, press the emergency button for direct communication to the life and safety monitoring station. This telephone line is designated for emergency use only, and must not be used for any other purpose.

General Pool Policy

- Nudity is prohibited.
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area or pool at any time.

Pool Furniture Policy

- No reservation of pool furniture is allowed. Any furniture left unaccompanied for 15 minutes is deemed abandoned and may be used by other residents.
- Pool furniture is not to be removed from the pool deck area by anyone other than an authorized representative of the Corporation.
- No outside furniture is allowed except for personal portable chairs and loungers.
