How to Contact Us?

Brookfield will be supplying a full-time Property Manager, supported by a Site Administrator, who will be located in the on-site Property Management Office. We will advise you of the location and contact information for the Property Management Office and Concierge once they are confirmed. In the interim please contact Brookfield as follows:

The Head Office phone number for Brookfield is 416.510.8700, and this number is personally answered 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. After occupancy begins the Concierge Desk will be your first point of contact in the event of an emergency. However, you may also contact anyone from the Brookfield team at any time.

Arranging to Move In

You can reserve the moving elevator by calling Ms. Monica Pineda at 416.354.1957. It is necessary that all paperwork be completed before you move-in, and earliest move-in date may only be scheduled for 24 hours after Interim Closing (your possession date). Reservations will be made on a "first-come, first-served" basis, so you may wish to call at your earliest opportunity.

Please note that you cannot be given access to your suite until all necessary paperwork is received and the Interim Closing is complete.

There is only one bay available for move-ins/deliveries. In order to accommodate everyone as efficiently as possible, we are scheduling a maximum of 4 time slots per day, Monday through Saturday. Each booking will be for 2.5 hours, at a maximum.



THE STATION CONDOMINIUMS MOVE-IN GUIDELINES

When planning your move into The Station Condominiums, please take note of the following matters which you <u>must consider</u> and <u>must be aware of</u> on your move-in day:

BOOKING CONTACT

All moves must be booked in advance. Dates and times are available on a first-come basis. Please call Ms. Monica Pineda at Brookfield Condominium Services head office on her direct line at: 416.354.1957. In case of emergency, 416.510.8700 is answered 24-7.

TRUCK / TRAILER SIZE

No moving truck larger than a 20-foot household mover may be used. A truck of this size easily handles up to 3 bedrooms of household goods. There is simply not room to accommodate any vehicle larger than 20 feet. Please ensure that your mover is made aware of this requirement. All truck and trailer parking on the main street does not fall under our authority and should not even be considered as an option.

LOADING / UNLOADING BAYS

There is one location available for your move-in truck to unload your furnishings. Access to the moving bay is located on the east of the building beside the parking ramp. There are two dedicated move-in elevators — one for the east side of the building and one for the west.

ARRIVAL AT THE BUILDING

When arriving at the condominium residences please contact the Concierge. The Concierge will place the elevator applicable for your suite on service and provide you with a first floor plan for easy reference.

MOVING TIPS

We would like to remind you that it is critical that your movers/move-in truck arrive on time and that the **2.5 Hour Move-In Time Limit be strictly observed**. Schedules have been set and given the move-in requirements of the site, arrival and departure times must be maintained.

When unpacking, please flatten and break up all boxes, cartons, etc. Garbage/Recycling Room where you must dispose of all cartons is located on the P1 level, off west elevator lobby.

Under no circumstances may move-in boxes be left in your corridor or thrown down the garbage chute. Boxes left in your corridor pose a safety and fire hazard; as well boxes thrown down the chute will plug up the chute, entrap household waste and lead to garbage odors escaping into the corridors.

Thank you in advance for your co-operation and we hope you have a problem free move-in.

Please ensure that your movers arrive on time and are finished within the prescribed period. In order to ensure that the next scheduled move-in is not disrupted, you must give up the use of the elevator at the end of your reserved time-slot. If you miss your reserved time, it may be difficult to reschedule your move-in. We have enclosed an information bulletin entitled, "Move-in Guidelines", to assist you in planning your move.

Until the mail room is complete and Canada Post commences its mail delivery, your mail may be picked up at the Canada Post Letter Depot located at 66 Ray Avenue, Toronto, Ontario, telephone 416-604-4995, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Canada Post requires that you bring proper identification with you (photo ID and proof of ownership showing proper municipal address – i.e. Purchase and Sales Agreement).

Common Elements

While your suite will be complete when you move in, the corridors are not scheduled to be finished until most of the suites on your floor are occupied. This is done to avoid any damage to the finishes during move-ins. For those of you who will be among the first occupants, the amenity spaces will still be under construction and not available for use, however, the Builder has assured us that they are working to complete them as quickly as possible. We thank you for your patience and understanding.
