Do's and Don'ts



Because hardwood and wood fiber based flooring is a living material, it will expand and contract with changes in moisture conditions. Wood floors will expand during hot and humid summer months. The use of a dehumidifier is recommended during summer. Air conditioning is also recommended to help remove the moisture from the air.

Wood floors will contract during the dry, winter season. Gaps may develop between boards. The use of a humidifier is recommended during the winter.

A relative humidity level of 30-35% is ideal and recommended. Not only is this level ideal for your hardwood, but also for your health.

Prevent Unnecessary Exposure to Moisture

Floor mats should be checked thoroughly to ensure no moisture is trapped underneath. Windows and doors should be closed during rainy weather and wall or rood leaks must be corrected immediately.

Direct Sun Light

Exposing wood floors, particular dark wood or exotic species, to direct sunlight may cause changes in colour overtime. Drapes or other window coverings to block direct sunlight will help minimize this.

- Sweep or vacuum your floor
- Use floor protectors under the furniture
- Keep your pets nails groomed
- Keep water off the floor surface
- Wipe up spills and dirt as soon as possible
- Use rugs and floor mats in high traffic areas
- Avoid walking on your floor in spike-heeled shoes
- Prevent indentation marks and scratched
- Do not use a buffing machine
- Do not use a wet mopping process for cleaning
- Do not use soaps or strong detergents
- Do not use water emulsion type of waxes
- Do not use oil treated sweeping/mopping compounds
